

This region is home to the native Bushmen, and s also home to one of southern Africa's last surviving zebra and wildebeest migrations. The region is synonymous for its desert species such as the meerkat and the elusive brown hyena, the third rarest carnivore in the world. Today you will be transferred back to the airstrip for your onward flight via light aircraft to Maun.

Day 8:

Today you will be transferred back to the airstrip for your onward flight via light aircraft to Maun Airport. Here you will connect with your onward flight home.
