Sabi Sand Private Game Reserve

The Sabi Sands is South Africa's premier private game viewing destination. It was here that the southern African safari began and today this famous reserve offers exceptional game viewing and equally exceptional accommodations. Two perennial rivers, the Sabi and the Sand flow through this Game Park, sustaining the diverse fauna and flora of the area.

The success of leopard viewing within the Sabi Sands is legendary. Elephants, lion, rhino, buffalo, cheetah, giraffe, zebra and a vast variety of antelope and other species can be closely observed in their natural environment.

Overnight: Londolozi Varty Camp

The campfire has burned here for over 86 years making Varty Camp the symbolic heart and soul of Londolozi. All rooms have private swimming pools framed by timber decks that overlook the riverine bush. The living spaces are raised off the ground and shaded under a cathedral of trees. The camp has a pleasingly down-to-earth quality and the emphasis on family heritage means that children always have a place at Varty Camp.



Mont Rochelle Hotel & Vineyard, Franschhoek

Idyllically situated in the Cape Winelands, this peaceful country retreat is one of the oldest towns in South Africa. The town was named Franschoek, meaning "French Corner" as it was founded by French Huguenots settlers who fled the inquisition in Europe and were seeking a secluded little hide-out.

Overnight: Mont Rochelle Hotel & Vineyard

Mont Rochelle, Sir Richard Branson's South African Hotel and Vineyard, is nestled in a picturesque corner of Franschoek at the foot of the Klein Dassenberg Mountain Range and is ideal for relaxation and a superb culinary experience accompanied by some outstanding wines.

Mont Rochelle has 22 rooms including six suites all arranged around the main building. The Merlot Rooms are larger than the standard Shiraz Rooms and boast magnificent views of the valley.

There are two restaurants, a cosy bar, a spa, a gym and a heated outdoor pool. That's not forgetting a 37 hectare vineyard and wine cellar of course!
